



## ► Intellect in a New York state of mind

SPECIALIST IT recruitment consultancy **Intellect** has moved premises in Manchester city centre as it seeks to capitalise on jobs growth in the energy and retail banking sectors.

The consultancy, which was bought by AIM-listed company **InterQuest** for £4.6m in July 2007, has moved from Mosley Street to 3,000 sq ft offices at Bruntwood's No 1 New York Street. The firm employs 28 staff.

Intellect managing director David Di Domenico said: "Since becoming part of the InterQuest Group in 2007, Intellect has continued to go from strength to strength."

He said the move gave the business more space to enable it to continue to grow.

Mr Di Domenico said the consultancy was seeing particularly strong prospects in the energy sector, especially in project management, which suggested clients were starting to move again.
